

Preposition Pa(n), ku(n), l-, feraxei, si(n), and words that are formed from these

words.

Pronoun A word that precedes a subject marker and cannot be preceded by

a.

Reduplicated A new word that is formed by repeated the first one or two syllables

of another word.

Subject marker Gu, ga, ka, madi, di(a), and naga.
Suffix A syllable added to the end of a word.

Transitive A verb that must normally be followed by *a* and a noun or *naan*.

Uncountable noun A word that may be, but does not have to be, preceded by *a*, cannot

be preceded by mun, and is referred to using ka and not di.

Verb A word that can be preceded by *ka* or *di*.
